NOVICE TRAINING SHOW & CLINIC
Manor Farm, Whitecross Green, Murcott, Oxfordshire OX5 2RF

This is an informal, fun, training Show where help and advice will be given. Habits need not be worn in classes 1 and 2, but smart competition dress code should be used where habits are not worn. Horses/ponies may be shared in classes 1 & 2.

Safety hats to current safety standards as defined in Rules 11 and 12 below must be worn whilst mounted by all Junior competitors at all times and by any Adult competitor in Classes 1 & 2. For all other classes see Rule 12 (Adults) below.

Class 1 – Novice Walk & Trot

Aimed at absolute novice riders, lead rein riders, and/or horses new to side saddle. Honesty is appreciated in the spirit of a novice show. Riders may choose to show canter in their individual show but it is not required. Habits need not be worn and horses may be shared

Class 2 - Novice Equitation Class

Open to Adult and Junior riders who have never competed in a Side Saddle Equitation Qualifying Class. A short simple show will be required. Habits need not be worn and horses may be shared (*Qualifying Points for Equitation Championship classes at the National Show are not awarded in this class*)

The SSA Area 5 Novice Shield kindly donated by **Jane Nicholas** will be awarded to the winner of Class 2.

Class 3 – The Adult and Junior Intermediate Equitation Qualifying Class

Open to Adult Members – see the qualifications for the Adult Intermediate Equitation Championships in SSA Handbook Section II (2) and to Junior Members who have not been placed in the first 6 in a previous Junior Open Championship class within the last three years. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for SSA rosettes to 3rd place and SSA Championship Points.

Class 4 – The Side Saddle Association Equitation Championships Open Qualifying Class

Run under SSA Rules defined in the current Member's Handbook. Open to SSA Members and Non-Members. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for SSA rosettes to 3rd Adult and 3rd Junior places and SSA Championship Points. **Southernden Farm** offers a rosette to the highest placed Junior Member aged under 14 on 1st January of the current year. A rosette in memory of **The Late Mr R Philpot** is offered to the Adult Member and **Manor Grange Stud Show Centre** to the Junior Member, judged to be the best turned out. A Special

rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Mature Rider over 45 years old kindly sponsored by **Constance, Lady Bayliss.**

Area 5 Rosettes to sixth place in all classes.

Special rosettes to all juniors who have not competed side saddle before.

Area Show Points Awards

To the Adult and Junior Area 5 Member of the SSA gaining the most points at the Area 5 Novice Training Show, Spring Show at the H.O.P.E Show, Pre-Championship Show and Masters Show on the same horse/pony.

Points will be awarded as follows:

6 points for first place, 5 points for second place and so on down to 1 point for sixth place
To be presented at the Area 5 AGM.

Sheila Rowland Master Class Final

The four highest placed ADULT riders in Class 4 will qualify for the Sheila Rowland Masters class Final to be held at the Area 5 Masters Autumn Show on Sunday 1st September 2019. Qualification may go down to 6th place in the event of previously qualified competitors.

Training Clinic with Ginny Oakley-Pope

Following the above classes there will be a Training Clinic for those who wish to improve their flat work and jumping with Ginny Oakley Pope. Lessons will be in groups with a maximum of 4 people in each group. The cost will be £20 per person; payment with entry please. You may book for the training clinic even if you are not taking part in the show classes.

From the A41:

From the Bicester ring road turn onto Aylesbury Road, A41. Turn right towards Ambrosden. Continue through Ambrosden on Ploughley Road. Bear right onto Norris Road passing through Arncott. Bear right onto Murcott Road. Turn right at T junction. Turn left into Manor Farm approximately ½ mile after the T-junction and follow signs to parking area.

From the A420 Headington Roundabout:

Take the exit on to Bayswater Road; at the mini roundabout continue forward. At the T-junction turn right on to the B4027 and immediately turn left. Turn right onto Church Lane; continue forward on to Horton Hill. Turn left onto Brill Road. At the next junction, turn left down Panshill. Continue past T-junction. Manor Farm will be on your left after ½ mile. Follow signs to the parking area.

Rules

1. All classes shall be ridden side saddle
2. Classes may be divided for the purposes of preliminary judging if numbers require
3. Judges' decisions are final
4. **Entries close 7th April** - LATE ENTRIES will be accepted if classes are not already full, at an additional cost of £2.00 each.
5. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry and to alter, amalgamate or cancel classes

6. All dogs to be on non-extending leads
7. There will be no ambulance in attendance although there will be trained First Aiders on the showground
8. All competitors and those in attendance are reminded of their individual responsibilities with regard to Health & Safety, not only to themselves but others on the show ground. This responsibility extends to safe parking of vehicles and management of horses/ponies
9. No responsibility will be accepted by SSA Area 5 or Manor Farm for any accident howsoever it is caused
10. FALLS: A fall of horse/pony or rider in any class run under Side Saddle Association rules will result in disqualification, and the rider must leave the ring dismounted. It is strongly recommended that medical advice is then sought before competing in any other class.
11. JUNIOR COMPETITORS (SSA Members or Non SSA Members): MUST have attained their 5th birthday and be under 18 on 1st January of the current year and MUST wear a correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hat that meets one of the following current Safety Standards in all classes affiliated to or run by the SSA: All PAS 015; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. In addition the new BS/EN standard will be allowed, once approved with the finalised number being advised in due course.
 - 11.1. A Spur or Spur band is not permitted to be worn by a Junior in any class where jumping is involved.
12. ADULT COMPETITORS (SSA Members or Non SSA Members): MUST be aged 18 or over on 1st January of the current year and MUST wear a correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hat that meets one of the following current Safety Standards where indicated in the competition rules: All PAS 015; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. In addition the new BS/EN standard will be allowed, once approved with the finalised number being advised in due course Where safety hats are not compulsory, Adult competitors wear alternative headgear at their own risk.
13. LEAD REIN competitors MUST compete Hors Concours in any SSA affiliated class unless otherwise stated.
14. QUALIFIERS: Shows held up to and including the first day of the 2019 National Side Saddle Show will be Qualifiers for 2019. Shows held after that date will be Qualifiers for the following year.
